RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY EXTENDING TIME TO AWARD CONTRACT AND AWARDING CONTRACT TO MIDTOWN CONSTRUCTION SERVICES AS BEST AND LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR PROJECT MB-1688-R, OLD CITY JAIL WINDOW IMPROVEMENTS, 200 NORTH SHARTEL AVENUE, \$187,429; AND APPROVING CONTRACT AND BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has determined Midtown Construction Services was the lowest and best bidder for Project MB-1688-R, Old City Jail Window Improvements, 200 North Shartel Avenue; and

WHEREAS, provisions of the Oklahoma State law known as the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974, provides a contract for construction of a public improvement be awarded within 30 days or within 45 days for good cause shown or within 120 days upon mutual agreement between the lowest responsible bidder and the awarding public agency or agencies; and

WHEREAS, bids were received on July 31, 2024, and due to the time required to receive executed contract and bonds and the time necessary to route documentation to City Council for approval, contract award was thereby delayed, preventing award within 30 days of receipt of bids; and

WHEREAS, a letter agreeing to honor the bid through November 19, 2024 has been received from Midtown Construction Services; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Public Works Department to award the contract to Midtown Construction Services as the lowest and best responsible bidder in the amount of \$187,429.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby extend time to award, and award contract to Midtown Construction Services as the lowest and best responsible bidder for Project MB-1688-R, Old City Jail Window Improvements, 200 North Shartel Avenue, \$187,429; and approving contract and bonds.
