

JOINT RESOLUTION

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY AND THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM THE 2017 GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND AUTHORIZATION (2024 SALE) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,074,975 FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADVANCED ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES CONTRACT AND RELATED EXPENSES FROM THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY FOR PROJECT MP-0591, HEFNER GOLF COURSE CLUBHOUSE, 4491 SOUTH LAKE HEFNER DRIVE; AND, ASSIGNING CONTRACT FROM THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY TO THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority (OCMFA) and Allford Hall Monaghan Morris entered into a contract on July 5, 2022, as follows:

Project MP-0591, Hefner Golf Course Clubhouse; and

WHEREAS, the original contract provided for the Architect's preparation of plans and specifications for Hefner Golf Course Clubhouse, 4491 South Lake Hefner Drive; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation that this project would be funded in the City's 2017 General Obligation Bond Authorization, the OCMFA engaged the Architect to provide for advanced design and other architectural services related to this project; and

WHEREAS, 2017 General Obligation Bond Authorization (2024 Sale) funds in the amount of \$1,074,975 have been made available for the project and the project is fully funded; and

WHEREAS, staff, therefore, recommends that The City of Oklahoma City (City) authorize purchase of the advanced architectural services contract and related expenses from the OCMFA with 2017 General Obligation Bond Authorization (2024 Sale) funds for Project MP-0591 in the amount of \$1,074,975; and

WHEREAS, the OCMFA having no further funding or other contractual responsibilities related to Project MP-0591, staff additionally recommends that the OCMFA assign all rights, titles and interest in and to Project MP-0591, entered into on July 5, 2022, to The City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that The City of Oklahoma City hereby authorizes payment to the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority, from 2017 General Obligation Bond Authorization (2024 Sale) funds in the amount of \$1,074,975 for purchase of OCMFA advanced architectural services and related expenses expended to date on Project MP-0591.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority, having no further funding or other contractual responsibilities for Project MP-0591, hereby assigns and The City of Oklahoma City hereby accepts assignment of all Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority's rights, titles and interest in and to the above described agreement.
