AMENDMENT #2

AIR QUALITY SMALL GRANT CONTRACT
BY AND BETWEEN THE
ASSOCIATION OF CENTRAL OKLAHOMA GOVERNMENTS
AND
THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY

The below referenced terms hereby amend the Contract Agreement #CMAQ2022-04 between the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments (hereinafter "ACOG") and the City of Oklahoma City (hereinafter "Grantee") and dated the 1st of March 2022.

Stated Contract is for funds that are intended for the reimbursement of certain costs incurred for the creation of bicycle lanes along Linwood Boulevard.

May it be known that the undersigned parties do hereby agree to make the following changes and/or additions outlined below. These changes and/or additions shall be held valid as if included in the original contract referenced above.

Paragraph B, Section B.1. of the original Grant Contract is hereby amended to extend the term of Part I and Part II as follows:

B. GRANT CONTRACT TERMS

- B.1. ACOG shall have no obligation for costs incurred by the Grantee outside the period commencing with the Notice to Proceed date and ending 48 months after the Notice to Proceed date, hereinafter referred to as Part I of Contract Terms.

Paragraph C, Section C.3. of the original Grant Contract is hereby amended to designate the addressee party of Part II and Part III as follows:
