Will Rogers World Airport Title VI Plan, effective January 25, 2024, through January 25, 2027.

Background:

As a recipient of federal grant funds, the Oklahoma City Airport Trust (Trust) has agreed to comply with certain federal grant assurances that require the Trust to adopt a Title VI Plan in compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. § 2000d et seq.), Age Discrimination Act of 1975, P.L. 94-135, (42 U.S.C. § 6102), Airport and Airway Improvement Act of 1982, Section 520 (49 U.S.C. § 47123), and the U.S. Department of Transportation's (DOT) regulations to effectuate Title VI, at 49 CFR Part 21, to ensure against discrimination based on race, color, national origin (including Limited English Proficiency (LEP)), age, sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity), or creed at the Will Rogers World Airport. DOT Order 1000.12C, June 11, 2021, requires the FAA to conduct a Title VI Assessment and confirm the Sponsor receiving substantial Federal financial assistance ensure nondiscrimination before awarding Federal financial assistance. A current Title VI Plan may be sufficient to meet the FAA's Title VI Assessment. A Title VI Plan has been prepared to comply with updated Federal guidance and regulations and to re-establish the Trust's overall Title VI compliance. If this Title VI Plan is approved, the Director of Airports will ensure its adherence. The Director of Airports will make any necessary administrative adjustments to update complaint procedures, contact information, or any other minor changes that do not change the Title VI Plan's intent.

Through the outreach programs outlined in the Title VI Plan, Airport staff will promote nondiscrimination compliance.

Recommendation: Plan be approved.
