Ratifying and approving Addenda Nos. 1 and 2; awarding contract to Rudy Construction Co., Project MP-0608, Trail Alignment, Parallelling I-44 between Woodson Park and SW 74th Street ending in close proximity to Oklahoma City Community College, \$3,975,795.55; assigning Standard Testing and Engineering Company as the testing laboratory; and approving contract and bonds. Wards 5 and 6.

### Background:

This American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) project provides for a new trail meeting all Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) design requirements, wayfinding in accordance with the Parks Department Trail Signage Masterplan, and trail amenities such as benches, shelters, and solar lights.

The project was advertised, and bids were received from prospective bidders. Addenda were required to restate required federal documents and revise plans and specifications.

Construction is scheduled to begin in early 2025 and be completed in Summer 2025.
