Title of Item: Ordinance declaring a 725-day moratorium on the acceptance of new applications for, processing of, and issuance of planned unit developments and simplified planned unit developments that would allow construction on, or use of, property within 660 feet of Lake Hefner Parkway from a southern boundary of NW Expressway to a northern boundary of Memorial Road of Oklahoma City for freestanding signs with a display surface area over 200 square feet and on the acceptance of new applications for, and issuance of, electrical, building or sign permits for freestanding signs over 200 square feet associated with rezoning applications submitted during the moratorium; providing an appeal process; providing effective and expiration dates; providing severability; and declaring an emergency.

Description of Impact

On August 16, 2022, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 27,135 to declare a temporary 180-day moratorium which is proposed to be extended 725 days or until such time as Lake Hefner Parkway is designated as a Scenic Corridor in accordance with the new sign ordinance. The ordinance also provides for an appeals process, severability and the declaration of an emergency to make the Ordinance immediately effective.
