

City Council Action Financial Impact Report

Title of Item: Ordinance Relating to Nuisances, Amending Sections 35-175, Definitions, 35-189, Vehicle Used for Prostitution-related Transportation or Prostitution-related Criminal Activity, a Drive-by Shooting, a Speed Contest Violation, or an Eluding a Peace Officer Violation, 35-190, Procedure Used to Abate Public Nuisance per se Relating to a Vehicle Used for Prostitution-related Transportation or Prostitution-related Criminal Activity, a Drive-by Shooting, a Speed Contest Violation, or an Eluding a Peace Officer Violation

Originating Department: Police Department

Description of Impact: This ordinance amendment enacts provisions that provide for placing a nuisance abatement hold on vehicles used intentionally to block traffic on city streets and highways. Section 35-175 is amended to add a definition for “vehicle used to block vehicular traffic,” and to add omitted references to “speed contest violation” that should have been added when Ordinance 25,000 was adopted in 2014. Section 35-189 adds the legislative rationale for adding “vehicle used to block vehicular traffic” to the Criminal Activities Public Nuisance Abatement Ordinance. Section 35-190 adds “vehicle used to block vehicular traffic” to the procedural provisions pertinent to vehicle-abatement holds.

Summary of Impact

a. Cost to City Organization (include indirect costs): No additional cost to city organization.

b. Cost to Citizens: No additional cost to citizens except that necessary to reclaim nuisance vehicles. Police Department charges an administrative fee of \$100.00 when a nuisance hold is released to an uninvolved vehicle owner. Municipal Code § 60-32-10.

c. Cost to Business Community: No additional cost to businesses expected.

d. Revenue Produced: Revenue produced will be based on the outcome of administrative hearings and cannot be predicted. Police Department charges an administrative fee of \$100.00 when a nuisance hold is released. Municipal Code § 60-32-10.
