

**RESOLUTION OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY WATER UTILITIES TRUST RATIFYING THE ACTIONS OF THE GENERAL MANAGER IN DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; APPROVING THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS, AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO JORDAN CONTRACTORS, INC., PROJECT SE-0050, EMERGENCY SANITARY SEWER REPAIRS, 200 NE 36TH STREET AND 810 NW 15TH STREET, \$585,443; RATIFYING ISSUANCE OF AN EMERGENCY WORK ORDER; AND APPROVING THE CONTRACT AND BONDS.**

**WHEREAS**, the sewer mains at the proposed locations must be replaced due to a collapse and breaks discovered during inspection; and

**WHEREAS**, the necessary repairs will include the installation of new sewer mains and the rehabilitation of adjoining manholes; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare that repairs be done in a timely manner to restore the operational capacity in the area; and

**WHEREAS**, the necessary repairs are beyond the immediate resources of the Oklahoma City Line Maintenance Division; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Manager declared an emergency to exist; and

**WHEREAS**, bidding documents were prepared for Project SE-0050, emergency sanitary sewer repairs, 200 NE 36th Street and 810 NW 15th Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Jordan Contractors, Inc., with a sealed bid in the amount of \$585,443, was determined to be the lowest responsible bidder for Project SE-0050; and

**WHEREAS**, the emergency contract for Project SE-0050 in the amount of \$585,443 was awarded by the General Manager to Jordan Contractors, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, Jordan Contractors, Inc., has signed the contract and bonds for Project SE-0050 for the bid amount of \$585,443; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer issued an emergency work order.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Trustees of the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust that they do hereby ratify the actions of the General Manager in declaring an emergency; approving the bidding documents; and awarding a contract to Jordan Contractors, Inc., Project SE-0050, emergency sanitary sewer repairs, 200 NE 36th Street and 810 NW 15th Street, \$585,443; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Trustees of the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust that they do hereby ratify issuance of an emergency work order; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Trustees of the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust that they do hereby approve the contract and bonds.
