Final acceptance, Project PC-0795, residential sidewalk and pavement repair, May Avenue to I-44 from SW 89th Street to SW 104th Street; and placing maintenance bond into effect. Ward 5.

Location:

May Avenue to I-44 from SW 89th Street to SW 104th Street

Background:

This 2017 General Obligation Bond Authorization provided for street resurfacing and repair. The work was constructed using unit price contract PM-0284, Purchase Order No. 147042, for residential sidewalk and pavement repair. This project repaired 3.39 miles of streets.

PM-0284 establishes a unit price for residential sidewalk and pavement repair throughout the City, with engineering services provided by Public Works staff as needed.

The project has been constructed in accordance with the specifications and is ready for final acceptance.

Maintenance Bond No. GR43674 will be laced into effect with Granite Re, Inc., and will remain in effect until August 16, 2023.
