Oklahoma City Airport Trust Aircraft Deicing/Anti-Icing Material Storage and Use Agreement with United Airlines Inc., for the storage of aircraft deicing and anti-icing materials, OKC Will Rogers International Airport, annual revenue of \$2,400, retroactive to July 1, 2024. Ward 3.

Background:

United Airlines Inc., (United), currently has a Passenger Airline Use and Operations Agreement for Signatory Airlines (UOA) with the Oklahoma City Airport Trust (Trust) and has the option to enter into an Aircraft Deicing/Anti-Icing Material Storage and Use Agreement (Deicing Agreement) with Trust to lease ground space for the purpose of installing and operating one or more above-ground deicing and/or anti-icing storage tank(s) in conjunction with the United's operation of an air transportation business at the Airport. United's materials storage must comply with this Deicing Agreement, the Airport's De-Icing/Anti-Icing Policy effective as of December 1, 2023, and their UOA. The current deicing storage agreement with the Trust is in holdover status but shall terminate with the approval of the new UOA.

There are currently seven airline deicing storage tank sites located on the Airport, of which United leases two sites. This new Deicing Agreement will co-terminate on the same date as the UOA.

The City of Oklahoma City is not a party to the Deicing Agreement with United, but is approving the Deicing Agreement as required by the City's Lease Agreement with the Trust.
