Revocable Pipeline Permit with Phillips 66 Carrier, LLC to construct, operate and maintain a liquid hydrocarbons pipeline (16 locations). Ward 7.

Location:

Crossing East Memorial Road, 544 feet west of North Westminster Road and
Crossing North Post Road, 3,209 feet south of East Memorial Road and
Crossing NE 122nd Street, 2,773 feet west of North Post Road and
Crossing North Douglas Boulevard, 2706 feet of East Hefner Road and
Crossing East Hefner Road, 1,189 feet east of North Midwest Boulevard and
Crossing East Britton Road, 1,110 feet east of North Midwest Boulevard and
Crossing North Midwest Boulevard, 2,521 feet south of East Britton Road and
Crossing East Wilshire Boulevard, 3,072 feet east of Newberry Road and
Crossing NE 63d Street, 5,206 feet east of North Air Depot Boulevard and
Crossing North Air Depot Boulevard, 2,606 feet south of NE 63rd Street and
Crossing NE 50th Street, 1,405 feet east of North Sooner Road and
Crossing North Sooner Road, 623 feet north of NE 46th Street and
Crossing NE 46th Street, 632 feet west of North Sooner Road and
Crossing NE 36th Street, 1,945 east of North Bartell Road

Background:

This permit allows Phillips 66 Carrier, LLC to construct, operate and maintain a pipeline on a portion of the City's rights-of-way and utility easements. This permit is for liquid hydrocarbons pipeline. The pipeline crossing length is 1,163 feet, a total of 73 rods.

It is expressly agreed that in the event the City makes a request to relocate said appurtenances to the company's pipeline operation located in City right-of-way/utility easement, the company will comply and relocate the appurtenances and bear the entire cost. The crossings are to be place a minimum of 10 feet below grade in the right-of-way/utility easement.

Revenue:

Initial inspection and regulation fee of \$81.50 per rod for pipelines laid in City right-of-way/utility easement. All revenue is to be deposited in the General Fund – General Operations – Leases-Pipeline Inspection (1001-43600004).
