Preliminary Engineering Report, Project PC-0917, Off-Road Trail, Eastern Avenue from Grand Trail to SE 59th Street; and authorizing preparation of final plans and specifications. Ward 4.

Location:

Eastern Avenue from Grand Trail to SE 59th Street

Background:

This American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) project provides for a 10-foot-wide multi-use path that will be adjacent to the street, as well as improvements to existing bus stops. This project has regional significance since it connects existing bike facilities on SE 59th Street (an STBG-funded project from a prior year) and the Grand Boulevard trail. From a broader perspective, it will connect the new Draper Lake Draper trails to the rest of the trail network.

Final Plans are expected late 2024, with construction scheduled to begin in early 2025.
