Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving price adjustment, Core & Main, LP (C209010), brass meter service materials, estimated annual cost \$675,000, retroactive to February 28, 2025 through November 4, 2025.

Background:

The Utilities Department uses brass valves and fittings because they are resistant to corrosion, create tight seals, are durable, and comply with the no-lead requirement and American Water Works Association specifications.

On November 5, 2019, the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust (OCWUT) approved a three-year Pricing Agreement with Core & Main, LP (C209010) for brass meter service materials, estimated annual cost \$125,000.

On December 21, 2021, OCWUT authorized an estimated annual increase of \$100,000 to a total estimated annual cost of \$225,000, for the period ending November 4, 2022.

On October 25, 2022, OCWUT renewed the agreement for an additional three-year term, November 5, 2022, through November 4, 2025, estimated annual cost \$250,000.

On March 28, 2023, OCWUT authorized an increase of \$175,000 to a total estimated annual cost of \$425,000, for the period ending November 4, 2025.

On February 18, 2025, Core & Main, LP notified OCWUT of price adjustments for parts from their suppliers. Price adjustments range from 41 percent to 50 percent and catalog discount prices will be reduced by 10 percent.
