## The City of OKLAHOMA CITY

Joint Resolution with The City of Oklahoma City authorizing the Director of Risk Management and the Trust's legal counsel to enter into a Joint Petition Settlement of the Workers' Compensation Commission Claim No. CM3-2024-05363R styled: *Daniel Trujillo, Claimant vs. The City of Oklahoma City, Respondent*, an Own Risk Carrier, and further authorizing the Municipal Counselor to assist said counsel in the rendition of said Joint Petition Settlement to Judgment as authorized by 85 O.S. §346, 62 O.S. §§365.1 *et seq.* and Article 10, Section 28 of the Oklahoma Constitution.

### **Background:**

The Claimant, Daniel Trujillo is 59 years old and a 37-year employee of The City of Oklahoma City. At the time of the injury he was assigned to the Utilities Department as a Distribution Systems Inspector and continues to be employed by the City.

The Claimant sustained an undisputed accidental injury on May 24, 2024 to his upper back and low back.

The Claimant was evaluated by Dr. Lonnie Litchfield on behalf of his attorney and found to have the following permanent partial impairment: upper back 27%, low back 27%. The Claimant was also evaluated by Dr. William D. Jones on behalf of the City and found to have the following permanent partial impairment: upper back 2%, low back 2%. The negotiated Joint Petition Settlement calls for a PPD award of \$16,848 for the following permanent partial disability: upper back 8%, low back 5%.

The settlement further calls for a 3% assessment of the PPD award in the sum of \$505.44 be deducted and paid on behalf of the Claimant for the Multiple Injury Trust Fund Tax, making the lump sum award \$16,342.56. The settlement further calls for \$3,369.60 to be deducted from the PPD award and paid in a lump sum to Claimant's attorney as a fair and reasonable fee. In addition, the City will pay Court costs \$140, a Special Occupational and Safety Fund tax representing .75% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid in the sum of \$126.36 and the Workers' Compensation Administration Fund, representing 2% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid in the sum of \$336.96.
