Resolution waiving formal competitive bidding and authorizing the sole source purchase of inserts and caps from Hydrostadium, estimated cost \$158,230.76.

Background:

This Capital Improvement provides 4 work packages at the Oklahoma City Riversport ensuring the short-term plans do not preclude the long-term goals. Package 1 includes system improvements to both the competition and recreational channels.

The International Canoe Federation dictates what materials and equipment is permitted in their 'Canoe Slalom Homologated Sports Equipment List', which specifies what Whitewater Stadium Obstacles must be used. Hydrostadium is the sole source supplier of the Omniflot system; therefore, staff request sole source authority for the purchase of the required inserts and caps. Once the inserts and caps are obtained, the pre-building process can begin, which will likely help with the efficiency and readiness of the channel construction.

The International Canoe Federation requires these materials and Hydrostadium is the sole source supplier. It has been determined to be in the best interest of the City to waive formal competitive bidding and authorize the purchase.
