

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF \$356,324.05 FROM THE OKLAHOMA HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE; RATIFYING SUBMITTAL OF THE INTERNET BASED APPLICATION BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS MANAGER, AUTHOIRING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE POLICE BUSINESS MANAGER OR MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST TO SUBMIT THE INTERNET ACCEPTANCE, REQUESTS FOR FUNDS, PROVIDE REPORTS AS REQUIRED, AND TO ADMINISTER THE GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO RECEIVE AND DEPOSIT THE FUNDS IN THE GRANTS MANAGEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, this grant provides funding for the Oklahoma Impaired Driving Enforcement Drug Recognition Program (DRE). The DRE program is designed to assist in the identification and evaluation of drivers suspected to be under the influence of drugs leading to prosecution and adjudication of these impaired drivers, as directed by the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office (OHSO); and

WHEREAS, the grant period is October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides funding of \$356,324.05 for the Oklahoma City Police Department to coordinate and conduct training classes and certification sessions to train officers from various agencies in the state to become Drug Recognition Trainers and Experts to increase enforcement of DUI laws. The grant also provides the funding of a .85 FTE DRE State Coordinator and for the purchase of various supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS, no City match is required with this grant from the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Oklahoma City that the City is authorized to accept the award for the 2025 Oklahoma Highway Safety Office DRE Grant of \$356,324.05.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the submittal of the internet-based application by the Chief of Police and the Police Department Business Manager is ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Mayor is authorized to sign any necessary documents, the Police Business Manager or Management Specialist are authorized to submit the internet acceptance, to submit requests for funds, and to provide reports as required and administer the grant, and the City Treasurer is authorized to receive and deposit these funds into Grants Management Fund.
