RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF *MARCIA JOHNSON-KATHAN V. THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY*, OKLAHOMA COUNTY DISTRICT COURT CASE NO. CJ-2020-4974.

WHEREAS, the lawsuit styled *Marcia Johnson-Kathan v. The City of Oklahoma City*, has been filed in the District Court for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a settlement of Ninety-Four Thousand Dollars (\$94,000) is a just and reasonable settlement of said case.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to make such settlement by authorizing the Municipal Counselor to draft the necessary paperwork to settle this case and to prepare and file a Journal Entry of Judgment, which does not admit liability in said case.


