

RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING \$2,083,400.08 FROM THE MAPS 4 SOUTH MAY AVENUE TRAIL BUDGET, PROJECT M4-TR020, TO PROJECT MP-0608, TRAIL ALIGNMENT.

WHEREAS, the Trail Alignment project on South May Avenue from SW Grand Boulevard to SW 74th Street is an American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) project that provides for a new trail meeting all Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) design requirements, wayfinding in accordance with the Parks Department Trail Signage Master Plan, and trail amenities such as benches, shelters, and solar lights; and

WHEREAS, the project was designed and bid through the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Trail Alignment project includes two alternates that, if not awarded, must be included in the MAPS 4 Trails project; and

WHEREAS, after bids were received on November 20, 2024, Public Works staff informed the MAPS office that the available ARPA funds were not sufficient to award the two alternates; and


WHEREAS, the Public Works Department requested MAPS funding to award the alternates for the portion of the trail along South May Avenue from SW 59th Street to SW 74th Street; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends \$2,083,400.08 of the MAPS 4 Trails budget, Project M4-TR020, be transferred to the Trail Alignment project, Project MP-0608, to fund Alternates 1 and 2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of The City of Oklahoma City that \$2,083,400.08 of the MAPS 4 Trails budget, Project M4-TR020, be transferred to Project MP-0608, Trail Alignment.
