Contract with the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments, Project M4-TTG21, MAPS 4 Transit Planned Growth – Long Range Plan, grant of \$600,000, retroactive to July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025.

Background:

As part of the MAPS 4 Program, The City of Oklahoma City and EMBARK will develop a Long-Range Transit Plan (LRTP) to guide all future investments in public transit in the metro area for the next 30 years. The grant funds from the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments (ACOG) will be used for developing the LRTP, which will include all existing modes of public transit and future modes of transit being implemented by the Regional Transportation Authority of Central Oklahoma.

ACOG will grant \$600,000 to the City for the LRTP, and MAPS 4 will provide the required \$150,000 in matching funds as part of its \$1,097,821 contribution to the LRTP. The ACOG funds must be expended by June 30, 2025. The contract is retroactive to July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2025.
