

RESOLUTION APPOINTING JEFFERY BLACK, CLAUDIA CONNER,
LARRY HAZELWOOD, GARY HENRY, WALTER SUTTLE, PHILIP
WINTERS AND PAULA WOOD AS SPECIAL JUDGES TO A TERM OF
OFFICE BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024 AND EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2026.

WHEREAS, the legislature has enacted 11 O.S., §28-105, which provides in part that the City governing body in the event of the disqualification, disability or absence of a regular Judge of the Municipal Court of Record shall have power to appoint a Special Judge to sit for the duration of such disqualification, disability or absence; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 33 Section 24, of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, provides that the Council shall appoint a minimum of five Special Judges who shall be subject to the same qualifications and restrictions as a Municipal Judge and who shall act as a Municipal Judge during the absence, illness or disqualification of a Municipal Judge; each Special Judge shall be appointed to office for a term of two years and shall serve until their successor is appointed and qualified and the term of office for Special Judges shall expire on June 30 of the appropriate year; and

WHEREAS, the Council at the July 2, 2013 meeting (Item X.F.) set the fee for services of Special Judges of the Oklahoma City Municipal Court at \$100 per court session; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to appoint Jeffery Black, Claudia Conner, Larry Hazelwood, Gary Henry, Walter Suttle, Philip Winters, and Paula Wood as Special Judges to a term beginning July 1, 2024 and expiring June 30, 2026; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of The City of Oklahoma City that Jeffery Black, Claudia Conner, Larry Hazelwood, Gary Henry, Walter Suttle, Philip Winters, and Paula Wood are hereby appointed as Special Judges of The City of Oklahoma City Municipal Court for a term beginning July 1, 2024, and expiring June 30, 2026, upon the taking of the oath of office.
