Resolution authorizing acceptance of a \$442,000 grant from the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security, provided to the State of Oklahoma as part of the Fiscal Year 2023 Federal Emergency Management/Department of Homeland Security Grant Program; authorizing the Mayor to sign any necessary documents; authorizing the Police Business Manager or Management Specialist to submit the acceptance, approve claims, request funds, and provide reports as required; and authorizing the City Treasurer to receive and deposit the funds in the Grants Management Fund.

Background:

The Oklahoma City Police Department was selected to receive \$442,000, pursuant to the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security (OKOHS) fiscal year 2023 Homeland Security Grant Program. The 2023 program is providing funding for the purchase of Real Time Information Center (RTIC) equipment.

The RTIC equipment will be used by the Police Department to provide real time information gathering and support real time analysis and distribution of critical threat/hazard information. The project provides funding for camera purchases, installation, replacement and maintenance.

The 2023 Program is a federally funded grant using money provided to the State of Oklahoma as a part of the FY 2023 (FEMA/DHS) Homeland Security Grant Program. No grant match by the City is required.

Revenue:

\$442,000 to be deposited in the Grants Management Fund – Department of Homeland Security – OKOHS Police Grants – Grant Receipts – Real Time Information Center Grant (019-6970-4209006-G9998-G97538)
