

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE OF STREETLIGHT INSIGHT® SOFTWARE LICENSING AND SUPPORT SERVICES FROM STREETLIGHT DATA, INC., ESTIMATED COST \$582,945.60, DECEMBER 26, 2024, THROUGH DECEMBER 25, 2027.

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2023, Council approved Item No. IX.B., authorizing the purchase of Data Products, a one-year software subscription with StreetLight Data Inc., providing comprehensive and detailed traffic data effective through December 25, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the StreetLight Data software subscription has been instrumental in supporting the City's Streets Development Program (Traffic Impact Program) by providing comprehensive, real-time traffic data that enables the identification, assessment, design, and prioritization of critical traffic projects to address growing demands; and

WHEREAS, this data supports informed decisions about traffic flow, congestion, and road usage patterns, improving infrastructure planning and project design while serving as a foundational component for future pavement management software; and

WHEREAS, the data also plays a vital role in planning for the 2025 General Obligation (GO) Bond, ensuring data-driven selection of widening projects and intersection improvements to maximize community impact; and

WHEREAS, as Streets Development Fees are insufficient to fully address development-driven traffic demands, GO Bond funds supplement these revenues, requiring coordinated efforts guided by high-quality traffic data; and

WHEREAS, StreetLight Data, Inc. develops, sells, and is the sole provider of the StreetLight InSight® software licensing and support services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby authorize the sole source purchase of StreetLight InSight® software licensing and support services from StreetLight Data, Inc., estimated cost \$582,945.00, December 26, 2024, through December 25, 2027.
