**Title of Item:**

**Ordinance amending the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, relating to authorizing City employees to provide plumbing and mechanical services as journeymen on City facilities; amending Chapter 18 - Electrical Code, Article IV – Apprentices, Journeymen and Contractors, by amending Section 18-76 - Electrical journeyman; and amending Chapter 29 - Mechanical Code, Article IV – Apprentices, Journeymen and Contractors, by amending Section 29-76 - Mechanical journeyman.**

**Originating Department:** Utilities Department

**Description of Impact**

This ordinance includes administrative amendments to Chapter 18 and 29 to align City regulations with Oklahoma State law regarding the licensing and employment of journeyman electricians and mechanics for municipal utilities. This amendment clarifies that City-employed journeyman electricians and mechanics, who hold valid Oklahoma State licenses, can perform work on public utilities without the requirement to be employed by licensed contractors.
