Revocable Right-of-Way Use Permit with American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, to hold the "Out of the Darkness Suicide Prevention Walk," September 7, 2024, Mickey Mantle Drive between East Sheridan Avenue and East Reno Avenue, revenue of \$100. Ward 7.

Location:

Mickey Mantle Drive between East Sheridan Avenue and East Reno Avenue, Research Parkway, Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark, Bricktown

Background:

The "Out of the Darkness Suicide Prevention Walk" is a fundraising and awareness walk. This year is the first time since 2019 that the walk will use City streets. The last 4 years the event was held entirely in Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark.

Police officers will be placed throughout the course to minimize the impact on traffic and to make sure drivers and walkers remain safe.

The walk will begin at 8 a.m. The permit would be authorized for the street closure for the staging area from 7 a.m. until 11 a.m. to allow the event organizer sufficient time for setup, teardown and cleanup of the event site. The temporary course closures would be authorized from 7:45 a.m. to 11 a.m.
