Description of Impact

Ryan Smith, P.E., Senior Engineering Project Manager for Smith Roberts Baldischwiler, on behalf of their client John Rex Charter Elementary School, has submitted a request to establish a reserved parking space for the physically disabled on the east side of South Dewey Avenue south of West Sheridan Avenue.

At their regular meeting on October 16, 2023, the Oklahoma City Traffic and Transportation Commission voted in favor of the request and recommended it for approval by the City Council.
