

**Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS  
Amendment to Correct the Period of Performance**

This Amendment is to the Grant Agreement dated June 3, 2020 (Grant Agreement), Grant Number OKH20FHW001 (Grant), between the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and City of Oklahoma City (Grantee).

Whereas HUD awarded a Grant to the Grantee and sent a signed Grant Agreement to the Grantee for their signature; and

Whereas the Grant Agreement establishes the period of performance start date and end date, with the start date being the date the Grantee signs the Grant Agreement, and the end date being three years after the start date; and

Whereas the signed Grant Agreement did not provide the correct start date or end date to the period of performance or did not include the start date or end date to the period of performance in Box 7 & Box 8 at the top of the Grant Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, to correct the Grant's period of performance as established by the date that the Grantee signed the Grant Agreement, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. The period of performance under the Grant Agreement is corrected to start on June 3, 2020; and
2. The period of performance is three years and ends on June 2, 2023; and
3. This Amendment to the Grant Agreement, when signed by both parties where indicated, constitutes the entire agreement of the parties as to amendment of the Grant Agreement. The remaining terms of the Grant Agreement remain in full force and effect.
