Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving Renewal No. 2 of the Contract with Cimarron Construction Company, LLC, Project WC-1051, Lead Service Line Identification, not to exceed \$2,500,000, May 1, 2025 through April 30, 2026. Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Background:

Under the Environmental Protection Agency's Lead and Copper Rule Revisions, water utilities are required to create and maintain a lead service line inventory. The City of Oklahoma City is currently implementing a lead service line identification program, which will ensure the replacement of the lead service lines and reduce exposure to lead in the community's drinking water.

The Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust (OCWUT) notified Cimarron that OCWUT wishes to renew the contract under the same terms, conditions, and provisions as the contract and amendment, including the prices. The current contract includes the option of four one-year renewals. This is the second renewal.
