

## RESOLUTION

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING CLASSEN'S NORTH HIGHLAND PARKED HISTORIC DISTRICT AS ELIGIBLE FOR LISTING IN THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES

**WHEREAS**, Classen's North Highland Parked Historic District is located within the incorporated area of the City of Oklahoma City, roughly bound by NE 13<sup>th</sup> Street, N Lincoln Blvd, NE 16<sup>th</sup> Street, and I-235; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Register of Historic Places nomination demonstrates the importance of Classen's North Highland Parked Historic District to the history and culture of Oklahoma City; and

**WHEREAS**, Classen's North Highland Parked Historic District. is locally significant in the areas of History and Architecture; and

**WHEREAS**, Classen's North Highland Parked Historic District is an outstanding example of a collection of residential architecture of the early twentieth century; and

**WHEREAS**, Classen's North Highland Parked Historic District is representative of the historic development patterns of residential neighborhoods in Oklahoma City in the early twentieth century, including those by prolific Oklahoma City developer Anton Classen; and

**WHEREAS**, the Classen's North Highland Parked Historic District National Register of Historic Places nomination, prepared by Kristin Dyer, Dyer Need for Preservation LLC, is an accurate and scholarly written document; and

**WHEREAS**, this action is consistent with the provisions of Chapter 59, Section 3300.2 of the Historic Preservation Ordinance contained in the *Zoning and Planning Code; Oklahoma City Municipal Code, (2020)*.


### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION, THAT:**
