RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF *DORIAN QUILLEN v. CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY AND BISHOP CONSTRUCTION LLC*, IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY, CJ-2022-206 AND TO WAIVE POTENTIAL INDEMNIFICATION AGAINST BISHOP CONSTRUCTION LLC RELATED TO THIS ACTION.

WHEREAS, the lawsuit styled *Dorian Quillen v. City of Oklahoma City and Bishop Construction LLC* has been filed in the District Court for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a settlement of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) and an agreement on behalf of the City to not attempt to collect or demand indemnification for any amount related to this matter from Bishop Construction, LLC is a just and reasonable settlement of said case;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to make such settlement by authorizing the Municipal Counselor to draft the necessary paperwork to settle this case and to prepare and file a Journal Entry of Judgment, which does not admit liability in said case.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY that the Municipal Counselor be, and he is hereby directed to prepare and file all necessary paperwork to effectuate this settlement, including a Journal Entry of Judgment confessing Judgment without admitting liability, and to document, as necessary, that the City will not seek indemnification from Bishop Construction LLC or otherwise attempt to collect from Bishop Construction LLC related to this matter.
