

## RESOLUTION

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION RECOMMENDING THE DR. WILLIAM L. AND SUSIE PRICE HAYWOOD ESTATE AS ELIGIBLE FOR LISTING IN THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES

**WHEREAS**, the Dr. William L. and Susie Price Haywood Estate (“the Haywood Estate”) is located within the incorporated area of the City of Oklahoma City, at 7100 N Sooner Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Register of Historic Places nomination demonstrates the importance of the Haywood Estate to the history and culture of Oklahoma City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haywood Estate. is locally significant for its association with the lives of persons significant in our past; and

**WHEREAS**, the Haywood Estate is significant for its association with the lives of Dr. William L. Haywood, an African American physician and leading figure in the medical field and its integration through various institutions, and Mrs. Haywood, a civic leader in Oklahoma City’s African American community in the early to mid-20<sup>th</sup> century; and


**WHEREAS**, the Haywood Estate National Register of Historic Places nomination, prepared by Kristin Dyer, Dyer Need for Preservation, LLC, is an accurate and scholarly written document; and

**WHEREAS**, this action is consistent with the provisions of Chapter 59, Section 3300.2 of the Historic Preservation Ordinance contained in the *Zoning and Planning Code; Oklahoma City Municipal Code, (2020)*.


### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION, THAT:**
