

CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 12TH day of MARCH, 2024, by and between the CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY, party of the first part, hereinafter termed "City," and MANHATTAN ROAD AND BRIDGE COMPANY, party of the second part, hereinafter termed "Contractor."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City has caused to be prepared in accordance with law, certain specifications, and other Bidding Documents for the work hereinafter described and has approved and adopted all of said Bidding Documents, and has caused Solicitation for Bids to be given and advertised as required by law, and has received sealed proposals for the furnishing of all labor and materials for: Project M4-NPR11, MAPS 4 Park Enhancements, Public Spaces Transformation River – Phase I - Pedestrian Bridge, Base Bid Plus Alternates 1 and 3 and Accepting Unit Prices, as outlined and set out in the Bidding Documents and in accordance with the terms and provisions of said Contract; and

WHEREAS, Contractor, in response to said Solicitation for Bids, published in The Journal Record December 20 and 27, 2023, has submitted to the City Clerk of the City of Oklahoma City in the manner and at the time specified, a sealed proposal in accordance with the terms of this Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk in the manner provided by law has publicly opened, examined and canvassed the proposals submitted and the City has determined and declared the above named Contractor to be the lowest responsible Bidder on the above described project and has duly awarded this contract to said Contractor for the sum named in the proposal, to wit: Five Million Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars and Seventy-Six Cents (\$5,775,863.76).

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual agreements and covenants herein contained, the parties to this contract have agreed and hereby agree as follows:

1. The Contractor shall, in a good and first-class workmanlike manner, at its own cost and expense, furnish all labor, materials, tools and equipment required to perform and complete said work in strict accordance with the contract and plans adopted and approved by the City, all of which documents are on file in the office of the City Clerk and are made a part of this Contract as fully as if the same were herein set out at length, with the following additions and/or exceptions: (if none, so state) None.

2. The City shall make payments to the Contractor in the following manner: On or about the first day of each month, the Contractor will make accurate estimates of the value, based

on contract prices of work done and materials incorporated in the work and of materials suitably stored at the site thereof during the preceding calendar month. The Contractor shall furnish to the Program Manager such detailed information as he may request to aid him as a guide in the preparation of monthly estimates.

Each monthly estimate for payment must contain or have attached an affidavit as required by 74 O.S. § 85.22.

3. On completion of the work, but prior to the acceptance thereof by the City, it shall be the duty of the Program Manager and City Engineer to determine that said work has been completely and fully performed in accordance with said Contract Documents, and upon making such determination, said officials shall make final certificate to the City. The Contractor shall furnish proof that all claims and obligations incurred in connection with the performance of said work have been fully paid and settled; said information shall be in the form of an affidavit, which shall bear the approval of the surety on the contract bonds for payment of the final estimate to the Contractor; thereupon, the final estimate (including retainages) will be approved and paid and the same shall be in full for all claims of every kind and description said Contractor may have by reason of having entered into or arising out of this Contract.

4. The sworn and notarized statement below must be signed and notarized before this contract will become effective.
