Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Riverfront Redevelopment Authority in approving Contract for Professional Engineering Services with CEC Corporation, Project MC-0745, on-call engineer to serve the Oklahoma City Riverfront Redevelopment Authority, July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027. Wards 1, 3, 4, 6, and 7.

Background:

The City of Oklahoma City ("City") owns certain property within and adjacent to the North Canadian River Corridor ("River Corridor"), part of which is known as the Oklahoma River. The Oklahoma City Riverfront Redevelopment Authority ("OCRRA") is a public trust of which the City is sole beneficiary. OCRRA is charged with planning, development, and operation of the River Corridor for the use and enjoyment of the public.

The current on-call engineering services contract ("Contract") expires on June 30, 2024. OCRRA wishes to enter into this Contract, with CEC Corporation, for a range of as-needed services, including engineering studies and reports, construction plans and specifications, construction administration, and related activities. The Contract will be effective through June 30, 2027. On May 21, 2024, OCRRA approved the Contract.
