Revocable Permit with the Riversport Foundation for “TRI-OKC Riversport Challenge,” September 6-8, 2024, the Boathouse District and North Oklahoma River Trail, revenue of \$2,625. Ward 7.

Location:

North Oklahoma River Trail

Background:

Riversport Foundation (Permittee) desires a Revocable Permit (Permit) to hold “TRI-OKC Riversport Challenge” (Event), as described above. Permittee will, at its expense, plan, organize, and manage the Event.

The Permit will be effective when approved by the City. It will authorize Permittee to use Oklahoma City Riverfront Redevelopment Authority (OCRRA) property on the Event Site from 2:00 p.m. on Friday, September 6, 2024 until 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 8, 2024.

This Permit shall authorize Permittee to use public rights-of-way to establish a Criterium Course, a Triathlon Bike Course, and a Triathlon Run Course and 5K/10K Course.

Permittee must provide required insurance and indemnification; protect City property; and comply with applicable laws, rules, and regulations. As consideration, Permittee will pay OCRRA \$2,550 and pay the City \$75. On July 30, 2024, OCRRA recommended approval of the Permit.

Revenue:

\$2,550 to be deposited in OCRRA UNASN – OCRRA – PARKS CHG-SPECIAL EVENTS (5500 – REV3000 – 42050005)

\$75 to be deposited in General Operations- UASN – Culture and Recreation – Parks Charge-Special Events (1001-REV1500-42050011)
