I am writing to express my concern over the rezoning application at 10317 Hassett Rd (PUD-1813). I am an owner within 500 ft of this property and it directly affects my properties at 2213 NE 100th St and 2121 Sea Smoke. I fear that any changes to the zoning will make matters worse than they already are (please see attached photos). I ask that you help my family and I by DENYING application PUD-1813 for rezoning.

The majority of those that would be directly affected by these changes are families who chose to live in this area decades ago because it was peaceful, quiet, and beautiful. Many of our neighbors have put a great deal of time and effort into creating and cultivating their homes and properties here because of the beauty of the land and its sense of peace and tranquility.
