Photo taken 4.6.21. Shows piles of logs moved to the fence line between applicant and 10500 Joshua Drive, note also crushed plastic waste mixed in with the logs.



Photo taken 4.7.21. Same location as above. Massive increase of logs. This increase was associated with the use of a Bobcat compact loader for the majority of the day on 4.6.21. This is not an agricultural enterprise but an industrial operation. The noise pollution from the compact loader and chainsaw activity continues to limit comfortable use of outside spaces.
