Justification:	Experience from the Upper Park has shown that the color is imperceptible after 12 months of wear.
Description:	Remove integral color from the concrete paths. White cement and textured finish to remain.

Item No. 2 (PR-009-1)	Relocate Existing City Water Lines
Purpose:	To ensure integrity of the City water system.
Justification:	Existing water lines were not in surveyed locations and conflicted with other existing and proposed utilities.
Description:	Relocate approximately 115 feet of 6- inch water line and 40 feet of 10-Inch water line including associated valves and bends.
Time Extension:	None
