

**RESOLUTION OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY WATER UTILITIES TRUST EXTENDING THE TIME TO AWARD A CONTRACT, AWARDING A CONTRACT TO MCKEE UTILITY CONTRACTORS, INC., PROJECT WC-0874, ATOKA PIPELINE RAW WATER TRANSMISSION LINE, ADA PUMP STATION TO CANADIAN RIVER CROSSING, \$37,272,000; AND APPROVING THE CONTRACT AND BONDS.**

**WHEREAS**, Project WC-0874 installs 8.8 miles of raw water transmission line for the second Atoka Pipeline from the Ada pump station to the connection of the WC-0875 Canadian River crossing project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust (OCWUT) has advertised and received bids for Project WC-0874; and

**WHEREAS**, provisions of the Oklahoma State law known as the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974, provides a contract for construction of a public improvement be awarded within 30 days, or within 45 days for good cause shown, between the lowest responsible bidder and the awarding public agency or agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of OCWUT to award the contract to the lowest and best responsible bidder; and

**WHEREAS**, the bids were opened on March 9, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the time required to receive executed contract and bonds and the time necessary to route documentation to the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust for approval, contract award was thereby delayed, preventing award within 30 days of receipt of bids; and

**WHEREAS**, a letter agreeing to honor the bid for 60 days has been received from McKee Utility Contractors, Inc.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Trustees of the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust that they do hereby extend time to award a contract, award a contract to McKee Utility Contractors, Inc., Project WC-0874, Atoka Pipeline raw water transmission line, Ada Pump Station to Canadian River Crossing, \$37,272,000; and approve the contract and bonds.
