Ordinance relating to Massage, amending the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, Chapter 28, Sections 28-1, Definitions, and 28-30, Issuance

Originating Department: Police

Description of Impact

This ordinance amendment would change the definition of “sexual misconduct” to include a violation based on the fact of a violation, rather than a conviction, for rape, child molestation, prostitution, lewd behavior or any other crime where a person is required to register as a sex offender. It also disqualifies an applicant from obtaining a massage license if the applicant has a conviction, or pending charge, for a felony involving violence, a felony involving dangerous drugs or weapons, or for sexual misconduct. The amendment would also prohibit issuance of a massage license for a business located at an address in which the city can show that sexual misconduct has occurred within the two-year period prior to the application.
