

## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

**JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY AND THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE RISK MANAGER AND THE TRUST'S LEGAL COUNSEL NOT TO APPEAL AND TO COMPLY WITH THE ORDER OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COURT CLAIM NO. 2019-02060F, STYLED: GLYNIS BILLS, CLAIMANT, VS. THE CENTRAL OKLAHOMA TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING AUTHORITY, RESPONDENT, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO ASSIST SAID COUNSEL IN OBTAINING A SATISFACTION AND RELEASE OF JUDGMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, Glynis Bills caused to be filed an application for permanent partial disability benefits under the Workers' Compensation Act as a result of undisputed accidental injuries arising out of and in the course of his employment, with a date of injury on March 7, 2019, with the Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority, (COTPA); and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Oklahoma City administers its obligations to provide Workers Compensation coverage, and the obligations of the public trusts of which the City is the sole beneficiary, through the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the COTPA is a public trust, and the City of Oklahoma is its sole beneficiary; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Oklahoma City is self-insured under the laws of the Workers Compensation Commission and COTPA is an additional named insured on the City's Own Risk Permit No. IOR2021-00020; and

**WHEREAS**, for the reasons set forth in the attached memorandum which is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof, it is considered to be in the best interest of The Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority and the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority not to appeal and to comply with the Court Order.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT JOINTLY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City and the Chairman and the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma City

Municipal Facilities Authority that the Risk Manager and the Trust's legal counsel be authorized to settle by Joint Petition Settlement of the Workers' Compensation Commission Claim No.: CM-2019-02060F, styled: Glynis Bills, Claimant vs. The Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority, an additional named insured under Own Risk Permit No. IOR2021-00020. That in compliance with the Joint Petition Settlement, Claimant is to be paid a total amount of \$28,262.50 and an additional payment of 1,737.50, for additional consideration for a full, final, and complete settlement, plus any accrued interest, making the lump sum award, including the additional payment, \$30,000. Pursuant to Title 85 O.S. § 368, a filing fee of \$140 is taxed as a cost in this matter and shall be paid by Respondent, The City of Oklahoma City, to the Commission Administrator within 20 days from the date of the settlement. The settlement further calls for \$6,000 to be deducted from the PPD award and paid in a lump sum to Claimant's attorney as a fair and reasonable fee. In addition, the City will pay Court costs, a Special Occupational Health and Safety Tax Fund, representing .75% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid the sum of \$225 and the Workers' Compensation Administration Fund, representing 2% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid in the sum of \$565.25. Finally, that the Risk Manager and the Trust's legal counsel be authorized not to appeal and to comply with the Court Order as previously noted.

**BE IT FURTHER JOINTLY RESOLVED** that the Municipal Counselor is authorized to assist legal in obtaining a satisfaction and release of said judgment.
