

**EXTENSION OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA
CITY AND THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF
FIREFIGHTERS, LOCAL 157**

WHEREAS, the City of Oklahoma City, hereinafter referenced as the City, and the International Association of Firefighters, Local 157, hereinafter referenced as IAFF, have a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2021-2022, which addresses the wages, hours, and working conditions of Oklahoma City employees represented by IAFF. The 2021-2022 collective bargaining agreement operates through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, representatives for management and labor have been negotiating for a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2022-2023, but the parties have yet to reach a tentative agreement to recommend to the City Council and to the IAFF membership; and

WHEREAS, the parties believe it to be in their best interest to extend the 2021-2022 collective bargaining agreement as negotiations progress and a successor agreement is reached for 2022-2023, or June 30, 2023, whichever occurs first.

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE to extend the terms and conditions of the 2021-2022 collective bargaining agreement until a successor contract is agreed upon for 2022-2023, or until June 30, 2023, whichever occurs first.
