

**EXTENSION OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA
CITY AND THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE,
COUNTY, AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, LOCAL 2406**

WHEREAS, the City of Oklahoma City, hereinafter referenced as the City, and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, Local 2406, hereinafter referenced as AFSCME, have a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2021-2022, which addresses the wages, hours, and working conditions of Oklahoma City employees represented by AFSCME. The 2021-2022 collective bargaining agreement operates through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, representatives for management and labor have not reached a tentative agreement for a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2022-2023, to recommend to the City Council and to the AFSCME membership; and

WHEREAS, the parties believe it to be in their best interest to extend the 2021-2022 collective bargaining agreement while the parties continue to collectively bargain the 2022-2023 agreement, or until June 30, 2023, whichever occurs first.

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE to extend the terms and conditions of the 2021-2022 collective bargaining agreement until a successor contract is agreed upon for 2022-2023, or until June 30, 2023, whichever occurs first.
