Revocable Permit with the Riversport Foundation for the “Stars and Stripes Weekend 2,” July 2, 2022, using the Boathouse District, Regatta Park, and the Eastern Basin of the Oklahoma River. Ward 7.

Location:

The Boathouse District, Regatta Park, and the Eastern Basin of the Oklahoma River.

Background:

The Riversport Foundation (Permittee) desires a Revocable Permit (Permit) to hold the “Stars and Stripes Weekend 2” (Event), as described above. Permittee will, at its expense, plan, organize, and manage the Event.

The Permit will be effective when approved by the City. It will authorize Permittee to use the Event site from 9:00 a.m. on Friday, July 1, 2022, until 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 2, 2022. The Event will have motorboat racing demonstrations in the Eastern Basin; therefore, the Permit authorizes Permittee to allow boats to create a wake during the Event. There will also be a fireworks display; therefore, Permittee must obtain required approvals from the City’s Fire Marshal.

Consistent with the Amended Landscaping, Maintenance, and Related Public Amenities Lease Agreement among The City of Oklahoma City (City), the Oklahoma City Riverfront Redevelopment Authority (OCRRA), and Permittee, OCRRA will apply the Permit fee, totaling \$4,750, toward Permittee’s annual credit for event permits within, and adjacent to, its leasehold.

Permittee must provide required insurance and indemnification; protect City property; and comply with applicable laws, rules, and regulations. If the City Council approves the Permit, staff will docket it for receipt by OCRRA.
