

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE OF NON-LETHAL MARKING ROUNDS FROM ULTIMATE TRAINING MUNITIONS (UTM), (SS23-C237056), ESTIMATED COST \$100,000, SEPTEMBER 27, 2022 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 26, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Police Department have been requested that all sworn personnel take part in Active Shooter Training; and

WHEREAS, the most effective and beneficial type of training for this topic is one that can be as realistically as possible to simulate real world situations that officers may encounter; and

WHEREAS, the best way to accomplish this is through force-on-force scenario training utilizing a combination of role players and monitoring instructors that place student officers in various scenarios; and

WHEREAS, during these scenarios both Role Players and Student Officers can deploy training rounds (UTM Rounds) from an assortment of weapons platforms; and

WHEREAS, these UTM rounds are non-lethal marking rounds that are used in weapons platforms that have been modified to only accept these types of rounds and prevents the loading or firing of a live round, ensuring a safe training environment for student officers, role players, and instructors; and

WHEREAS, Ultimate Training Munition (UTM) is the sole manufacture for non-lethal marking rounds; and

WHEREAS, no other company makes a similar or competing product that closely matches what the officers carry on duty; and

WHEREAS, GT Distributors is an authorized dealer, however, the local GT Distributor stated they are not authorized to sell UTM products in the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, staff requests Council approve the sole source purchase of non-lethal marking rounds from Ultimate Training Munitions (UTM), (SS23-C237056), estimated cost \$100,000, September 27, 2022 through September 26, 2023; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby authorize the sole source purchase of non-lethal marking rounds from Ultimate Training Munitions (UTM), (SS23-C237056), estimated cost \$100,000, September 27, 2022 through September 26, 2023.
