

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT COVID
PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH
CITY RESCUE MISSION**

This Second Amendment revises Attachment "A" and Attachment "B" to increase the total amount of funding from \$841,960 to \$887,210. The \$45,250 increase in funding is allocated for Rapid Rehousing. All other provisions of the initial Agreement approved by the City Council on March 16, 2021 and the First Amendment approved by the City Council on May 24th, 2022 remain unchanged. The amended provisions now read as follows:
