

## **RESOLUTION**

**RESOLUTION DE-OBLIGATING \$78,763 IN EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS COVID (ESG-CV) ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDS AND APPROVING THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE ESG-CV PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH THE HOMELESS ALLIANCE INC TO ADD THE \$78,763, ALONG WITH AN ADDITIONAL \$255,518.07 IN UNCOMMITTED ESG-CV FUNDS TO RAPID RE-HOUSING SERVICES FOR A TOTAL INCREASE IN FUNDING FROM \$2,367,056 TO \$2,701,437.07.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2020 the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136 was signed into law; and

**WHEREAS**, On April 2, 2020, HUD informed the Planning Department that \$1,475,283 in ESG-CV funds had been allocated to the City of Oklahoma City; and

**WHEREAS**, On June 9, 2020, HUD announced an additional allocation of \$5,928,669 in ESG-CV funds to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the CARES Act allowed these funds to cover or reimburse allowable costs uncured before the award of funding, including prior to the CARES Act; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 4, 2020, the City Council approved an Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Agreement with the Homeless Alliance to provide services in response to COVID-19.

**WHEREAS**, the initial funding amount of this project was \$502,000 and the original term of the agreement was from March 15, 2020, through June 30, 2022.

**WHEREAS**, On January 19, 2021, the City Council approved a Resolution allocating funds for an Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Agreement with Mental Health Association Oklahoma to provide winter shelter services, and also allocating \$78,763 in administrative funds to the Planning Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the administrative funds were never used and remain unspent; and

**WHEREAS**, March 16, 2021, the City Council approved the First Amendment to the Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Agreement with Homeless Alliance, increasing the funding from \$502,000 to \$1,559,800, and extending the term of the Agreement through September 30, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 4, 2022, the City Council approved the Second Amendment to the Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Agreement with the Homeless Alliance, increasing the funding from \$1,559,800 to \$2,012,755; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 18, 2022, HUD issued Notice CPD-22-06, extending the expenditure deadline for ESG-CV funding to September 30, 2023; and,

**WHEREAS**, on May 24, 2022, the City Council approved the Third Amendment to the Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Agreement with the Homeless Alliance, increasing the funding from \$2,012,755 to \$2,367,056; and

**WHEREAS**, the Resolution being submitted for approval today will de-obligate the unspent \$78,763 in Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Administrative funds and amend the Emergency Solutions COVID Program Agreement with the Homeless Alliance to re-obligate the funds for Rapid Re-Housing services, along with \$255,618.07 in additional uncommitted Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program funds to increase the funding by \$334,381.07.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the \$78,763 in unspent Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Administrative funds be de-obligated and that the Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program Agreement with the Homeless Alliance be amended to re-obligate the funds for Rapid Re-Housing services, along with \$255,618.07 in additional, uncommitted Emergency Solutions Grant COVID Program funds to increase the funding by \$334,381.07.
