

JOINT RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE RISK MANAGER AND THE TRUST'S LEGAL COUNSEL NOT TO APPEAL AND TO COMPLY WITH THE ORDER OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSION CLAIM NO.: CM-2021-00013A, STYLED: *DERRELL WALLACE*, CLAIMANT, VS. THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY, RESPONDENT, AN OWN RISK CARRIER.

WHEREAS, Derrell Wallace caused to be filed an application for permanent partial disability benefits under the Workers' Compensation Act as a result of accidental personal injury arising out of and in the course of his employment on November 7, 2019, with The City of Oklahoma City; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons set forth in the attached memorandum which is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof, it is considered to be in the best interest of The City of Oklahoma City and the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority not to appeal and to comply with the Commission Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT JOINTLY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City and the Chairman and the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority that the Risk Manager and the Trust's legal counsel be authorized not to appeal and to comply with the Commission Order of the Workers' Compensation Commission Claim No.: CM-2021-00013A styled: Derrell Wallace, Claimant, vs. The City of Oklahoma City, Respondent, an Own Risk Carrier. That in compliance with the Commission Order, Claimant is to be compensated for 68.40 weeks for a total amount of \$23,940, of which 31 weeks have accrued and shall be paid in a lump sum of \$10,850, plus any accrued interest (less attorney fee). Claimant's attorney shall be paid \$4,788 or 20% of the PPD award as a fair and reasonable attorney fee. Pursuant to Title 85 O.S. § 368, a filing fee of \$140 is taxed as a cost in

this matter and shall be paid by Respondent, The City of Oklahoma City, to the Court Administrator within 20 days from the date this Order becomes final. In addition, the City will pay Court costs, a Special Occupational Health and Safety Tax Fund, representing .75% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid the sum of \$179.55 and the Workers' Compensation Administration Fund, representing 2% of the permanent partial disability award, shall be paid in the sum of \$478.80. Finally, that the Risk Manager and the Trust's legal counsel be authorized not to appeal and to comply with the Commission Order as previously noted.

IT IS FURTHER JOINTLY RESOLVED that the Trust's legal counsel be authorized to comply with the Workers' Compensation Commission Order for the amount of said award and the Municipal Counselor be authorized to assist in the Entry of Judgment of said award in the District Court of Oklahoma County, as authorized by 85 O.S. § 346, 62 O.S. § 365.1 *et seq.* Article 10, Section 28 of the Oklahoma Constitution, in the event the parties reach a Joint Petition Settlement or the award is commuted to a lump sum.
