Ordinance relating to Miscellaneous Provisions and Offenses, amending Chapter 30 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, Section 30-452, Purchase, receipt or possession of tobacco products or vapor products by persons under 21 prohibited, falsifying proof of age, fines.

Originating Department: Municipal Counselor

Description of Impact

This ordinance harmonizes city ordinance with recent state law that precludes city's from imposing criminal penalties for underage possession of smoking and vaping products.
