

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A \$400,000 2023 SAFE OKLAHOMA GRANT FROM THE OKLAHOMA OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, RATIFYING SUBMITTAL OF THE APPLICATION BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE POLICE BUSINESS MANAGER OR MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST TO SUBMIT THE ACCEPTANCE, REQUEST FOR FUNDS, PROVIDE REPORTS AS REQUIRED AND TO ADMINISTER THE GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO RECEIVE AND DEPOSIT THE FUNDS IN THE GRANTS MANAGEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, since October of 2013, City Council has accepted over \$4.6 million in Safe Oklahoma Grant funds. The funds have enabled the city to enhance its efforts to combat violent crime by using directed patrols, hot spot policing, community surveys, door-to-door interactions with residents, Intelligence-Led Policing, code enforcement practices, and multifamily housing crime reduction strategies in the designated target areas with high violent crime; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2022 an application was submitted for the continuation of the violent crime reduction programs for both the north and south parts of Oklahoma City; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$400,000 was approved for the program to address community-specific issues identified through community surveys and door-to-door interactions with residents. Police officers working the overtime program will focus enforcement efforts on issues important to residents, as well as proactive efforts to reduce violent crime; and

WHEREAS, it is projected that this grant will fund the program through December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require matching funds from the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The


City of Oklahoma City that the City accepts a \$400,000 2023 Safe Oklahoma Grant from the Oklahoma Office of the Attorney General.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the submittal of the application by the Chief of Police and the Police Department Business Manager is ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Safe Oklahoma Grant Program Contract is approved, the Mayor is authorized to execute the necessary documents, the Police Business Manager or Management Specialist are authorized to submit the acceptance, request for funds, provide reports as required and to administer the grant, and the City Treasurer is authorized to receive and deposit these funds into Grants Management Fund 019.
