Ordinance to be introduced and set for final hearing removing the No Parking Anytime restriction on the west side of North Cooper Avenue between NW 41st Street and NW 42nd Street. Ward 7

Originating Department: Public Works

Description of Impact

Isaac Farnsworth, Vice President of Facilities for Kimray, Inc., submitted a request to remove the No Parking Anytime restriction on the west side of North Cooper Avenue between NW 41st Street and NW 42nd Street.

Mr. Farnsworth stated in his request letter that Kimray, Inc. is changing the use of their building at the southeast corner of the North Cooper Avenue and NW 42nd Street intersection to office space and indicates Kimray Inc. would benefit from its workforce being able to park on the west side of North Cooper Avenue. Kimray, Inc. is the only business operation on the east side of North Cooper Avenue in the block between NW 41st Street and NW 42nd Street.

At their regular meeting on October 17, 2022, the Oklahoma City Traffic and Transportation Commission voted in favor of the requested change and recommended it for approval by the City Council.


