

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY TO ACCEPT, FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, A \$32,067 AWARD FROM THE DISTRICT ATTORNEYS COUNCIL FROM THE 2022 COVERDELL FORENSIC SCIENCE IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM; RATIFYING SUBMITTAL OF THE APPLICATION BY THE CITY MANAGER, CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE POLICE BUSINESS MANAGER OR MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST TO SUBMIT THE INTERNET ACCEPTANCE, REQUEST FOR FUNDS, AND PROVIDE REPORTS AS REQUIRED; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO RECEIVE AND DEPOSIT THE FUNDS IN THE GRANTS MANAGEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma City Police Department Forensic Chemistry Laboratory operates three Agilent Gas Chromatography/Mass Spectrometry instruments that are used to perform testing for controlled substances; and

WHEREAS, the oldest of the three instruments was purchased in 1997 and is in need of replacement. This grant would provide for funding 26% of the replacement cost and Police Sales Tax funds will pay for the remaining amount; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the City is authorized to accept a \$32,067 award from the District Attorneys Council from the 2022 Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the submittal of the application by the City Manager, Chief of Police and the Police Department Business Manager is ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Chief of Police and the Mayor are authorized to sign any necessary

documents; the Police Business Manager or Management Specialist are authorized to submit the internet acceptance, requests for funds, and provide reports as required, and the City Treasurer is authorized to receive and deposit these funds into the Grants Management Fund.
